

FAIR HOUSING PROCLAMATION
CLINTON, OKLAHOMA

The City of Clinton has received a Community Development Block Grant from the Oklahoma Department of Commerce for funding to update the City's Capital Improvement Plan. The CDBG dollars are funded by the United State Department of Housing and Urban Development.

The Oklahoma Department of Commerce requires that when a city or town receives a CDBG grant, the city or town will be required to take a step to further Fair Housing each year. By passing this Proclamation for the City of Clinton, the City would help promote Fair Housing within the city.

The month of April is the National Fair Housing month across the United States. The proclamation would normally be proclaim in April, however, since the CDBG grant funded in September, we would ask the city council to approve for 2013.

WHEREAS, it is illegal under the Fair Housing Act to discriminate because of race, color, religion, sex, handicap, familial status, or national origin, or intention to make any such preference, limitation or discrimination in housing; and

WHEREAS, the City of Clinton shall not knowingly tolerate discrimination in housing within the City of Clinton, Oklahoma;

NOW THEREFORE, as Mayor of the City of Clinton, I hereby declare that the month of April shall henceforth be recognized as Fair Housing Month, to be honored annually and continuously, in the spirit and intent of fair housing for all residents of the City of Clinton, Oklahoma.
