Re: Inter-Local Agreement

This inter-local agreement between Custer County commissioners and the fire departments in each city in Custer County is to verify that they will provide the fire departments with \$100,000.00 each year for the purchase of fire trucks and equipment to be used to protect the residents of rural Custer County. In the event that a new county commissioner is elected or new fire chief is hired, this document will allow for them to know what has gone on in the past and what is expected in the future. Our city council should approve this agreement to solidify a good working arrangement between the entities involved.

Inter-Local Agreement

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into this 10th day of February 2014 between Custer County Commissioners and the Custer County Fire Departments providing service to the rural areas of Custer County. The purpose of this agreement is to provide trucks and equipment to the departments from a dedicated source.

WHEREAS, in as much as this project is of mutual benefit to the citizens of Custer County, this AGREEMENT between the Custer County Commissioners, the listed Custer County Fire Departments and their Respective City Administration will be in force and binding upon the parties herein upon the execution of this AGREEMENT and shall continue in effect until the fourth regular board meeting of the Custer County Commissioner of FY2016. The renewal of this agreement shall, be held each two years thereafter on that same schedule. The Commissioners will be those dually elected or appointed and the fire departments shall be represented by their Chief and Assistant Chief.

1. The Custer county Rural Fire Truck & Equipment Use Tax Fund shall be the source of \$100,000.00 on an annual basis provided Use Sales Taxes are available. However, the Commissioners are not required to use all funds in a given Fiscal Year. Any unencumbered balance shall be carried forward to the next fiscal year upon discretion of the Board of Custer County Commissioners.

WHEREAS, should the scope of requested funding exceed one year's contribution, the Board of Commissioners may elect to enter lease purchase agreement(s) to provide needed equipment.

The parties hereto, through their respective governing bodies, hereby agree to the following:


1. CUSTER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS hereby agree to provide essential Trucks and equipment for The fire departments of Custer County with the above funding sources.

2. The Fire Departments of Custer County are in full agreement to maintain and provide proof of insurance on all trucks and equipment. All departments shall provide mutual aid for benefit of the residents of Custer County.

WHEREAS, pursuant to State Statues (title 19§421.2), county government has the ability to purchase equipment with sales tax proceeds, the statutes also require all equipment purchased to be offered to said county at such time the equipment is surplus, salvaged or made available for transfer to another district. The proceeds derived from insurance or sale of any equipment purchased by the Custer County Rural Fire Truck and Equipment Use Tax Funds shall be returned to said fund.

NOW THEREFORE, the said parties have caused this instrument to be executed by their respective officers the day and year above mentioned.


