Subject: Election dates and Filing Periods

A couple of months ago I spoke with Ann Brown at the Custer County Election Board to discuss filing periods and election dates. We referred to the Clinton City Charter that states the primary election shall be held every year on the Tuesday in August set by state law for special election. She explained to me that would be possible during odd numbered years but would be different in even number years. She said during even years the filing period would be in April.

It was decided that the filing period would be June 24, 25 and 26th with the election to be held on August 13th. She said the resolution would need to be submitted to the election board no later than June 13th. She also said to include a request to no open Prescient in Washita County due to the fact that there are less than 100 voters residing in the prescient.

I called Ann Brown last week following the Council meeting to confirm again the dates we had discussed for Clinton's filing period. Ann said that had had spoken with the City of Weatherford about setting the filing period for both communities at the same time and she had given out the wrong time frame for Clinton. She did reaffirm the filing period for Clinton has June 24, 25 and 26th with the election on August 13th.

The resolution setting the dates will be presented to the Council at the June 4th meeting.
