It is my opinion, after researching both bids, that we go with the Brindlee Mountain bid on a 1999 Pierce, Dash.

The reasons being are,

- 1) The ability to reach some of the larger 2-story houses, from the street, in the Rolling Hills addition. (100ft. vs. 85ft)
- 2) This truck has the original paint on it.
- 3) Central States Manf. has sold out to Rosenbaugher. (this is the other truck)
- 4) Larger generator. (over twice the kw)
- 5) Much lower miles. (15,000 vs. 71,000)
- 6) Pierce has just opened a new service center in west OKC, vs. Rogersville, MO
