**History/Background Information:** La Quinta Inn is a new hotel that is being built on the corner of Chapman Rd. and 28<sup>th</sup> St. There are currently no waterlines servicing this location. The nearest water sources do not have the pressure to meet the standards for needs of the hotel.

**Subject Summary:** Due to the lack of pressure, we are looking into running the waterline over from the 28<sup>th</sup> St. Water Tower. This line would run under I-40 and come out directly north of the hotel. We had only one contractor bid on this project; we obtained the best material price with vendors.

**Recommendation:** Contractor best price-Igo Ditching & Backhoe-\$30,177.50.

(Keaton Modi has agreed to pay for 50% of the costs)

Waterline price-HD Supply (City direct purchase)-\$24,169.55.

Engineer Estimate-\$84,920.00.
