

ORDINANCE NO. 947

AN ORDINANCE TO IMPLEMENT RESTRICTIONS ON THE
ADVERTISING OF TOBACCO AND TOBACCO PRODUCTS
AT CITY SPONSORED EVENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF CITY OF CLINTON, OKLAHOMA, Section 6-2A-9 of the Clinton City Code is hereby established to read as follows:

Section 6-2A-9. Advertisement of Tobacco Prohibited at City Sponsored Events.

(A) It shall be unlawful for any person or business to market or advertise, in any manner or method, products which contain tobacco or tobacco products at any event sponsored by the City of Clinton, Oklahoma.

(B) Events sponsored by the City of Clinton, shall include, but are not limited to: Sporting events, parades, dances, concerts or festivals, which the City of Clinton is solely responsible for.

(C) Any person who knowingly violates this act shall be punished in accordance with 1-4-1 of the Clinton City Code.

(D) Savings Clause - If a sentence, section, or any part of this article be deemed unconstitutional or void, such action shall not affect the remaining parts of this article.

(E) Repealer - All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict are hereby repealed to the extent if such conflict.
