**Background/Subject Information:**

Staff met with SWODA this week regarding potential grant opportunities. Also, Canute has obtained water agreements for the additional water Clinton needs. New MOU is being drafted for April meeting.

Infrastructure to get the water from Canute is required. CDBG funding is matching up to \$350,000. Early estimates put a new line around \$750,000. Deadlines for Applications, Resolutions, Surveys, and Public Hearings are approaching quickly. However, our situation is important and we believe we should be a strong candidate of any water grant.

**Recommendation:**

Staff recommends we move forward with all documentation of the CDBG Grant for Water infrastructure.

**RESOLUTION** 811

**WHEREAS**, Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, Public Law 93-383, as amended, authorized by the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, as representative of the United States of America, to grant to the State of Oklahoma funds and administrative responsibility for the "Small Cities Community Development Block Grant" program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Oklahoma Department of Commerce, pursuant to designation by the Governor as the administering agency of the Community Development Block Grant Program for Small Cities in Oklahoma, is directed to further the purposes of community development in the State, and is authorized and empowered to accept funds from the Federal Government or its agencies and to enter into such contracts and agreements as are necessary to carry out the functions of the Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Clinton, OK (Unit of Government) is a local unit of general purpose government that will provide opportunity for input by residents in determining and prioritizing community development needs through its written Citizen Participation Plan; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the (Governing Body) Clinton City Council that City of Clinton (Government Subdivision) desires to obtain assistance in community development and hereby requests the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to provide assistance under the policies, regulations, and procedures applicable to local communities in Oklahoma.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Clinton City Council (Governing Body) that City of Clinton (Government Subdivision) affirms its commitment to take all action within its power to facilitate the receipt of the assistance of community development funds if the City of Clinton (Government Subdivision) is awarded a Community Development Block Grant, and upon receipt to administer said grant by the rules and regulations established by the United States of America, the State of Oklahoma, and all empowered agencies thereof.
